# Hotel Less Sugar Campaign

#### Hotels Leading the Way to a Healthier Tomorrow

MAH, in collaboration with Tourism Productivity Nexus (TPN), Malaysia Productivity Corporation (MPC), Malaysian Association of Hotel Owners (MAHO), and Malaysian Budget and Business Hotels Association (MyBHA), proudly launched the Hotel Less Sugar Campaign to promote healthier hospitality practices. Supported by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (KKM) and Malaysia Healthcare Travel Council (MHTC), this initiative encourages hotels to display sugar and calorie content in their F&B offerings, raising awareness of sugar consumption.

The campaign was officially launched on 10th March 2025 at MPC Dewan Produktiviti, Menara MATRADE, officiated by YBhg Dato' Zahrul Hakim, Deputy Secretary General (Management) of the Ministry of Health, and recognised 72 pioneering hotels leading the movement. With 7 million Malaysians living with Type 2 diabetes, rising cases of chronic kidney disease, and 1 in 3 children affected by childhood diabetes, urgent action is needed. # Hospitality Industry Updates

#### MAH Urges Fair Licensing Fees to Protect Kota Kinabalu's Hotel Industry

The Malaysian Association of Hotels (MAH) is urging lawmakers in Kota Kinabalu to reconsider the sudden increase in hotel licensing fees, citing a severe financial strain on hotels of all categories, from budget stays to luxury establishments.


Following the reinstatement of the 1966 Hotel & Lodging Houses By-Laws, licensed hotels are now facing a significant rise in operational costs, while many unlicensed short-term rental (STRA) operators continue to operate without proper regulation. This unfair disparity puts licensed hotels at a disadvantage, making it unsustainable for them to absorb these excessive fees.

MAH is not opposing regulation but advocating for a fair and sustainable approach. The association urges the Sabah State Government and DBKK to:

- Suspend the fee implementation until proper consultation with industry stakeholders is held.
- Review the fee structure to create a balanced and sustainable licensing model.
- Regulate STRA operators to ensure fairness across the accommodation sector.
- Introduce transitional measures to allow hotels time to adjust to any fee revisions.

The tourism and hospitality sector is a key driver of Sabah's economy. A well-balanced approach is essential to maintain its growth, sustainability, and competitiveness. MAH calls for immediate dialogue to address these concerns before long-term damage is done to the industry.
